Phipps.

You are invited to submit nominations for this vacancy. Members of the bar may submit their own name or the names of others. The public is also invited to submit nominations. Such names should be sent to the Commission by September 12, 2016, (by letter addressed to Judicial Nominating Commission, c/o Dana McGuire, 600 Peachtree, N.E., Suite 5200, Atlanta, GA 30308-2216, by fax to 404-962-6919 or by email c/o dana.mcguire@troutmansanders.com).

If you have previously submitted an application for the three Supreme Court vacancies, upon notice to Dana McGuire, your application will be considered for this vacancy. No need to re-apply.

To each person nominated, the Commission will send an application package to be returned for receipt on or before October 3, 2016. The commission will meet sometime after October 17th to interview applicants. Applicants will be notified of the time for their interview. All interviews will be held at The State Bar of Georgia, 104 Marietta Street, Atlanta, GA 30303.

The Commission will select and recommend to the Governor from among those persons found to be "qualified" or "well qualified" a short list of up to five persons for each position.
