The commission will meet to interview applicants on November 13, 2018. Applicants will be notified of the time for their interview. All interviews will be held at The State Capitol in Room 107.

The Commission will select and recommend to the Governor from among those persons found to be "qualified" or "well qualified" a short list of up to five persons for this position.
